Requires 2 x AAA batteries (included)

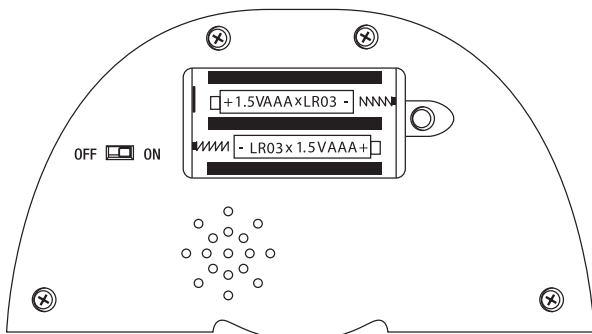
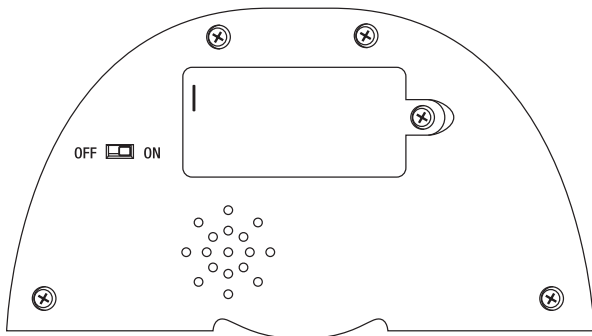
BATTERY WARNING:

- Replacement of batteries must be done by an adult
 - Do not mix old and new batteries
 - Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) batteries or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries
 - non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged
 - rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision
 - rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged
 - different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed
 - batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity
 - exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy
 - the supply terminals are not to be short-circuited
 - Instructions for replacement of batteries
- Please retain the information for future reference.

BATTERY OPERATION:

Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the unit. Remove the screw on the battery compartment door with a small phillips screw driver and remove the battery door.

Insert 2 x AAA Batteries with correct polarity into the battery compartment. Replace the battery door and the screw. Unit is now ready for operation.



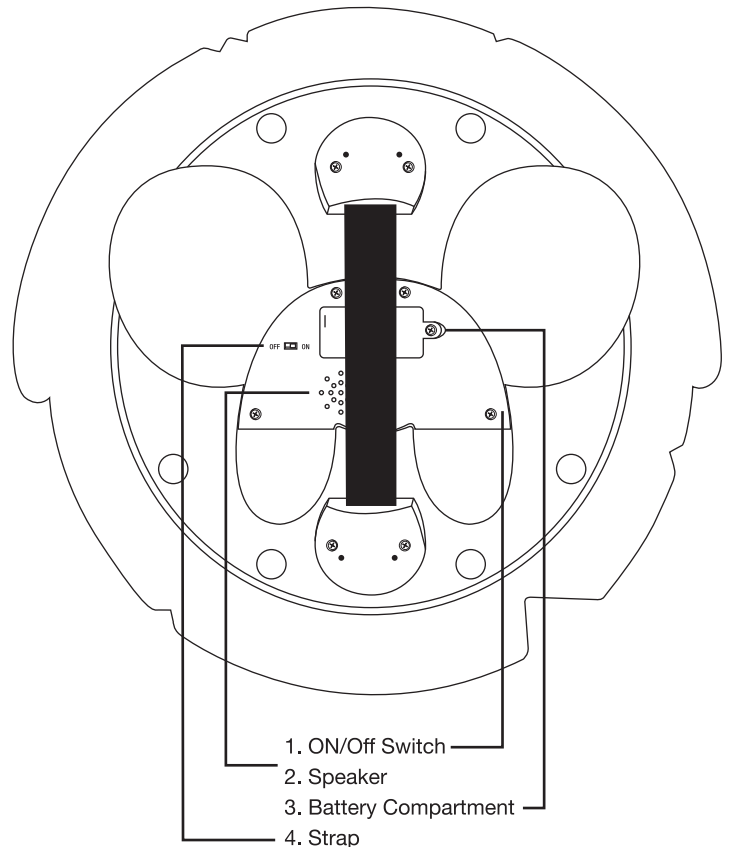
How It Works

The Jake Shield can make 3 different sound effects from the Adventure Time show.

To begin using the Jake Shield, first make sure the unit has fresh batteries inserted. Next, slide the function switch from the OFF position, to the ON position.

Now you are ready to battle with the Jake Shield. Hold the Jake Shield in front of you and when the shield is struck or hit, you will here jake say one of the phrases from the show.

When you are finished using your Jake Shield, select the OFF position until you are ready to use the product again. This will help extend the life of the batteries.
