

This product contains a low power laser device.

Follow the advice below for safe operations.

ON PROTECTION AGAINST LASER ENERGY EXPOSURE

- As the laser beam used in this compact disc player is harmful to the eyes, do not attempt to disassemble the casing.
- Stop operation immediately if any liquid or solid object should fall into the cabinet.
- Do not touch the lens or poke at it. If you do, you may damage the lens and the player may not operate properly.
- Do not put anything in the safety slot. If you do, the laser diode will be ON when the CD door is still open.
- If the unit is not to be used for a long period of time, make sure that all power sources are disconnected from the unit. Remove all batteries from the battery compartment, and unplug the AC cord from the wall outlet. Make it a practice to remove the AC cord by grasping the main body and not by pulling the cord.
- This unit employs a laser. The use of controls or adjustment or performance of procedures other than those specified here may result in exposure to hazardous radiation

ON PLACEMENT


- Do not use the unit in places where are extremely hot, cold, dusty or humid.
- · Place the unit on a flat and even surface.
- Do not restrict the air-flow of the unit by placing it in a place with poor ventilation, by covering it with a cloth or by placing it on a carpet.

ON CONDENSATION

- When left in a heated room where it is warm and damp, water droplets or condensation may form inside the unit.
- When there is condensation inside the unit, the unit may not function normally.
- Let it stand for 1 to 2 hours before turning the power on, or gradually heat the room up and dry the unit before use.

Should any trouble occur, remove the power source and refer servicing to qualified personnel.

Using Your Boombox:

AC OPERATION

Connect the plug to the AC SOCKET of the unit and the other end to a standard AC outlet.

ATTENTION

- 1. Do not plug or unplug the power cable while you have wet hands.
- When planning not to use this unit for a long time, disconnect the power cable from the wall outlet.
- 3. When disconnecting the power cord from the wall outlet, do not pull on the cord in order to avoid shock risks caused by damaged cable.

BATTERY OPERATION

Disconnect the AC cord set completely. Open the battery compartment door and insert 6 pieces UM-2 "C" size batteries into the battery compartment with battery polarity as shown inside the battery compartment. (Batteries not included)

<u>Using The Radio:</u>

- 1. Slide the FUNCTION SELECTOR to RADIO position.
- Slide the BAND SELECTOR to AM or FM position.
- 3. Turn the TUNING CONTROL to your desired radio station.
- 4. Adjust the sound level by rotating the VOLUME CONTROL.

For best reception, fully extend the FM antenna to receive FM stations. For AM reception, the unit has a built-in antenna, turn the whole unit for best reception.

Using MP3/Aux In Connection:

- Insert one side of the audio cable (requires 3.5mm stereo plug, not included) into the line-out jack or phones jack on your MP3 player and the other side to the AUX-IN JACK on the unit.
- 2. Turn on the unit and slide the FUNCTION SELECTOR to AUX/OFF position.
- 3. Turn on your MP3 player and follow the playback instruction.
- 4. To stop this function, simply turned off your MP3 player.

<u>Using Stereo Headphone Jack:</u>

For private listening, insert the plug of a stereo headphone into the PHONES JACK and adjust the volume control accordingly. During the use of a headphone, the speakers are automatically disconnected.

Playing a CD:

- 1. Set the FUNCTION SELECTOR to the CD position.
- 2. Insert the CD with the printed side facing up and close the CD door.
- 3. The total number of tracks in the entire CD will appear on the LED display.
- 4. To start playing the CD, press the PLAY/PAUSE button.
- 5. Adjust the VOLUME CONTROL to the desired volume level.
- 6. To stop playing the CD, press the STOP button.

To skip tracks:

- 1. During play or pause mode, press the SKIP NEXT button will go to the next track.
- During play or pause mode, press the SKIP PREVIOUS button will go back to the beginning of the track.
- After step 2, press the SKIP PREVIOUS button again will go back to the previous track.

Programing the CD Player:

The programming of the CD player should be done during STOP mode.

- Press the PROGRAM button, the LED display will show '01' and flash continuously.
- Press the SKIP NEXT or SKIP PREVIOUS buttons to select the desired track.
- Press the PROGRAM button again to store this track in memory, the LED will show '02' and flash continuously.
- Repeat steps from 2 to 3 to store more tracks in memory. You can store up to 20 tracks in the memory.
- 5. Press the PLAY/PAUSE button to play the disc in the programmed order.
- 6. To stop playing, press the STOP button.
- To cancel the programming list, press the STOP button and open the CD door or select a different function (AUX/OFF or RADIO).

Repeat Mode

Repeat 1: Press the REPEAT button once, the repeat LED indicator will light and flash continuously. This single track will be repeated.

Repeat All: Press the REPEAT button twice, the repeat LED indicator will stay lighted. The whole disc will be played continuously.

<u>To Cancel Repeat Function:</u> Press the REPEAT button until the lighted repeat LED indicator turned off.

Care and Maintenance:

- · Always turn off the unit after use.
- Keep the unit away from magnetic objects, water or heat sources.
- Use a clean soft cloth moistened with lukewarm water to clean the cabinet.
 Never use chemical cleaners that could damage the finish of the unit.
- Never touch the CD pickup and lens. If fingerprints get on the pickup lens, clean it gently with a commercial lens cleaner.
- · Disconnect the unit from any power sources before cleaning.
- To remove a disc from its storage case, press down on the centre of the case and lift the disc out, holding it carefully by the edges.
- Fingerprints and dust should be carefully wiped off the disc's recorded surface
 with a soft cloth. Unlike conventional records, compact discs have no grooves
 to collect dust and microscopic debris so gently wiping with a soft cloth should
 remove most particles. Wipe in a straight line from the inside to the outside of
 the disc. Small dust particles and light stains will have absolutely no effect on
 reproduction quality.
- Never use chemicals such as record sprays, anti-static sprays, benzene or thinners to clean compact discs. These chemicals can irreparably damage the disc's surface.
- Discs should be returned to their cases after use. This avoids serious scratches that could cause the Laser pickup to skip.
- Do not expose discs to direct sunlight, high humidity, or high temperatures for extended periods. Long exposure to high temperatures can warp the disc.
- Do not stick paper or write anything with a ballpoint pen on the label side of the disc.
