


 User Guide Microphone

INSTRUCTIONS

OperationRemove "try-me" pull tab from battery compartment on back of unit to gain full functionality of microphone. Turn the microphone switch to "ON" and press Plex button to hear songs and phrases and activate flashing lights.



To Replace Batteries:Locate battery compartment and "ON/OFF" switch on the back of the microphone. Ensure microphone switch is set to the "OFF" position. Using a screwdriver, unscrew the battery door compartment and insert batteries, following correct polarity and adhering to the battery warnings below. The microphone requires 2 x AAA batteries (included). Close the battery door and replace the screw in position.

Troubleshooting

- Make sure microphone is turned on and active.
- Wait for singing or phrases to stop before pressing Plex button again.
 If sounds begin to become distorted, replace batteries.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
